Health Guarantee:

1. Seller guarantees that the above puppy has been seen by a veterinarian, given appropriate shots, wormed and been given a clean bill of health. Your puppy will be shipped in good health and free, to the best of Seller's knowledge, from genetic defect. The medical records for above puppy will be provided at time of delivery.

2. Upon receipt of the puppy, buyer has three days to take the puppy to a licensed veterinarian for an examination and send a copy of the exam results to Classic City Labradoodles. If puppy is diagnosed with a serious health problem, immediate proof of examination and diagnosis is required. Classic City Labradoodles reserves the right to request a second opinion, by a veterinarian of our choice. This health

guarantee will be terminated immediately if a licensed veterinarian has not examined the puppy within the allotted three days with appropriate documentation sent to Classic City Labradoodles. If the puppy is

found to be in poor health within three days then the buyer has the option of returning the puppy immediately to the seller, at buyer's expense for a full refund, or puppy from the next available litter. If buyer decides to keep the puppy the seller will reimburse for all veterinary costs, up to the purchase price of the puppy, related to treatment of any pre-existing condition.

3. The seller provides a two year health guarantee from the date of sale against any debilitating congenital defects that affect the quality of the dog's life, provided the seller has fulfilled the following requirements. In the event the puppy exhibits symptoms of a suspected debilitating congenital defect, the buyer must supply any requested veterinary records to the seller within seven days of informing the seller of the defect. The seller has the right to require a second opinion from a veterinarian of the seller's choice at the seller's expense. If the puppy is euthanized or in any way disposed of, without a second opinion from the seller's veterinarian, the buyer waives all rights to a replacement puppy or any financial payment

as compensation.

4. This guarantee does not include viral illnesses, infections, improper bites, hernias, and hypoglycemia, giardia or coccidiosis. It also does not include any illness due to the ingestion of foreign objects, food, chemicals or physical injury.

5. If it is determined the puppy does have a genetic disorder that is identified within two years of purchase, the buyer has the option of either a replacement puppy from the next available litter or reimbursement, up to the purchase price of the puppy, of all veterinary expenses related to the illness. Your puppy need not be returned to us. Shipping fees will not be refunded, and if it becomes necessary to ship a replacement puppy, those fees are to be paid by the buyer.

6. If the puppy should die from a suspected congenital defect within the 24 months of its date of purchase, an autopsy must be performed at the buyer's expense by a veterinary teaching hospital or state licenses DVM acceptable to the seller's own veterinarian. If the autopsy shows a congenital defect as the reason for the death, the seller will provide another puppy of equal value to the buyer. A written statement from the veterinarian must be provided. This warranty is void in the event of an indeterminable or inconclusive diagnosis.

7. The seller has made a reasonable judgment regarding the eventual adult coat of the puppy. However, as these are living beings, this judgment does not guarantee the eventual adult coat nor is there a

guarantee of the eventual allergy-friendliness, degree of shedding or color of the coat at maturity.

8. No warranties or guarantees, expressed or implied, are made under this contract except as stated.

9. This health guarantee applies only to the buyer listed above and is not transferable to a subsequent owner.

Buyer's Responsibility:

1. The buyer agrees to pay the seller a total sum of \$ _____. This fee does not include shipping, if shipping is required.

2. The buyer bears all costs relating to the sale of the above animal, including transportation. The risk of loss or injury to the above animal is on the buyer at all times after the dog leaves the seller.

3. The buyer agrees to provide the dog with a caring and loving home.

4. The buyer agrees to take the dog to a veterinarian for an annual check-up and all preventative treatment recommended by the veterinarian will be followed.

5. The buyer agrees to feed their dog a premium dog food and give their dog regular exercise to maintain their dog at a healthy weight.

6. The buyer will not allow the dog to become overweight or allow repetitive, rigorous exercise during the first year of development.

7. The buyer agrees to provide active human companionship and socialization so that the dog grows into a healthy and stable pet.

8. The buyer agrees to provide basic obedience training within the first year of owning their dog.

9. The buyer agrees to contact the seller immediately if the buyer determines they are unable to keep their dog for any reason. The buyer and seller will determine how the dog will be re-homed. The buyer will never take the dog to a shelter or pound.

I have read and agree to the terms and conditions above. I also agree that this writing represents the entire agreement between both buyer and seller and that no other representations either oral or written have been made regarding the puppy described above.
